Facts Found:

CTRL J & Lola were on Starboard gybe.

White Knight was on a port gybe.

CTRL J haled "Starboard" to White Knight.

Lola gybed on to port.

White Knight did not keep clear of Lola and CTRL J.

Lola and Ctrl J took action to avoid a collision with White Knight. CTRL J hit Lola on her stern to avoid contact with White Knight.

CTRL J incurred significant damage to her bow sprit, Lola incurred

significant damage to her bow & rudder.

CTRL J retired from the race and returned to shore.

White Knight & Lola continued racing.

No penalty turns were taken.

Protest was hailed by Lola and CTRL J and protest flags flown.

Conclusions: White Knight did not keep clear of CTRL J & Lola.

CTRL J as a result avoiding a collision with White Knight hit Lola.

White Knight did not take penalty turns.

Rules that Apply: 10 – On opposite tacks

Decision: White Knight is disqualified from race 3 (of Saturday 31.05.2022)

for breaking rule 10. Under Rule 62.1(b) -

CTRL J shall be granted redress for race 3 of Saturday and the remainder of the regatta (if can't fix bow spirt). The redress given

shall be based on average points in the regatta up to and

including race 2 of Saturday 21.05.2022.

Lola shall be granted redress for race 3 of Saturday. Redress

shall be her finishing place, less one point.
