Facts Found: PRO gave incorrect co – ordinates for a mark of the course over the

VHF radio to competitors.

In giving the course over the VHF the PRO said the mark of the

course to be sailed was Diffuser to starboard.

Three Little Pigs asked for the co ordinates for the Diffuser Mark.

PRO told the fleet the incorrect co ordinates.

The incorrect co ordinates given related to the "Sewer" mark. Both marks are "Special Marks", the same shape and there is no

name displayed on the bouys,

All of the boats racing (except for "3 little pigs") sailed the course with

Diffuser to starboard.

The Course sailed by 3 little pigs was no larger in nautical miles, but

on the water the marks were about 5 - 10 degrees different.

Conclusions: 3 Little Pigs sailed the course co-ordinates given by the PRO.

PRO admits giving the incorrect course co-ordinates over the VHF.

Three Little Pigs should be given redress for race 2 of the day.
